FACILITIES

FORMAT

Eight teams will be accepted for each bracket on a first-come, first-serve basis. Teams are guaranteed to play 3 games.

ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is limited to school teams that have played or will be playing together during the current season. Parish-based teams that play as parish-based teams during the regular season are also eligible. Guest players are not allowed. No AAU teams, select/all-star teams, or club teams are eligible. Players may not play below their grade level.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Tournament fee is \$145 per team. Entry deadline is December 23, 2011. Paid entries received by December 9, 2011, will receive a \$10.00 discount (\$135). Entry submission **MUST** include payment, School/Roster Form, and Hold Harmless Agreement. All entry fees are non-refundable after December 23, 2011.

2012 Port Catholic Phoenix Shootout Rules

**7th & 8th Grade Boys & Girls Tournament
January 16 - 22, 2012**

1. Games will be played at St. Peter's of Alcantara Campus in Port Washington and Immaculate Conception in Saukville.
2. Team trophies will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams. 1st place teams will also receive individual trophies.
3. Only league rosters allowed. No AAU, Select/All-Star teams, or club teams are eligible.
4. Players may not play below their grade level. All dressed players are required to play, however there is no minimum playing time requirement.
5. All players must meet their schools academic requirements.
6. Games will be played according to WIAA rules.
7. Two WIAA referees will work all games. All decisions by referees are final. Protests are not allowed.
8. All games will have 4 6-minute quarters and a 5-minute halftime. Teams are allowed 3 full and 2 30-second timeouts.
9. Overtime will be 3 minutes and 1 additional timeout.
10. Girls and boys will use normal free throw line in tournament.
11. Any defense will be allowed, however, if a team leads by 15 points or more, the full-court press must be taken OFF. Violations will result in a bench technical (2 free throws, plus possession) after 2 warnings.
12. Games times are approximate. Please tell your players and fans to arrive early if possible. Please have your team ready to take the floor as soon as the previous game is over. Warm-up time will be limited to 5 minutes in most cases. Warm-up balls will be provided. Please do NOT bring practice balls.
13. The gym will open 30 minutes before the first scheduled game. The St. Peter's gym will not be open between 4:00pm and 5:00pm Saturday and will not open until 11:30am on Sunday. The Immaculate Conception gym will not be open between 5:00pm and 6:00pm on Saturday. Please share this information with your players and fans.
14. We provide locker rooms at the St. Peter's facility, however we are not responsible for lost or missing articles. Immaculate Conception does NOT have a locker room facility so please plan accordingly.
15. Water and popcorn only are allowed in the gym. We ask that all teams respect this request. No CARRY – INS allowed. Food, snacks and beverages are available at concessions and must be consumed in that area.
