TOURNAMENT RULES

PLAYING TIME

1. 5th-8th Grade Boys/Girls will play two 18 minute halves. The clock will be stopped on all whistles in the last two minutes of the half & game.
2. Teams will be permitted to take three 1 minute time-outs per game. One additional time-out will be allowed for each overtime period.
3. There will be intermission of 3 minutes between halves. There will be a minimum of 5 minutes between games.
4. If the score is tied at the end of the fourth quarter, 2 minute extra periods will be played until a winner is determined. There shall be a 1 minute intermission before and between each extra period.
5. All teams should be ready to play 5 minutes before their scheduled game. A team that does not have 5 eligible players and an adult coach within 5 minutes of the scheduled start of the game will forfeit.

CONDUCT OF PLAYERS, COACHES, BENCH PERSONAL, SPECTATORS

1. The head coach may stand in front of their bench to coach their team but not to berate an official.
2. All adult bench personnel are expected to set a good example of showing **RESPECT** for game officials & their decisions.
3. Players, coaches, or bench personnel who use profanity during a game will be charged with a technical foul. All technical, flagrant, & intentional fouls will be an **automatic 2 points & the ball**. Two technical fouls in a game from a coach or a player will result in an ejection from that game. Coaches or players ejected from the game **MUST** leave the gym within 30 seconds.

UNIFORMS

1. All jerseys, shorts & visible under-garments must be uniform for the entire team. Absolutely **NO JEWELERY – NO TAPING OVER EARNINGS**.

PROTESTS/COMPLAINTS

NO PROTESTS. Game officials decisions are final. All other rule interpretations will be the responsibility of the tournament director & game officials.

BACKCOURT PRESSURE/ZONE/MAN-TO-MAN DEFENSE

1. 5TH-8TH Grade may play a zone or man-to-man defense.
2. Full-court pressure is permitted during the entire game for 7th-8th Grade. **EXCEPTION**
– A team holding a **15 point lead** or more may not apply any defensive pressure in the opponent's backcourt & must retreat to the opponent's front court once an opponent clearly secures possession of the ball. 5th-6th Grade may press the last 2 minutes of the first half and the last 2 minutes of the game.

OTHER RULES

1. Practice balls **will not** be provided.
2. Locker rooms **are not** available.
3. **GAMES WILL NOT** be rescheduled after pool play is set. **PLEASE** list days/dates/times you **CANNOT PLAY**.
4. Team trophies for 1st place PLUS medallions for 1st & 2nd place.

TIEBREAKER

1. Head-to-Head Competition.
2. Least Amount of Points Given Up in 3 Pool Games.
3. Least Amount of Points Given Up in the First Half of 3 Pool Games.
