About Coach Claassen



Coach Joel Claassen coached the Pius XI High School girls varsity basketball team from 1984-2002. His overall record was 419-37. His teams have won 18 Conference Championships and 14 State Championships during this career. More than 30 of his student-athletes have received Division I

Athletic Scholarships. He has worked coaches' clinics throughout the state of Wisconsin and runs a grade school basketball camp that more than 4,500 athletes have attended.

Currently he is gearing up for his eighth season as the boys varsity basketball coach at Pius XI High School. His record in the past seven years is 103-58. His teams were WIAA Semifinalists in 2005 and Conference Champions in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008.

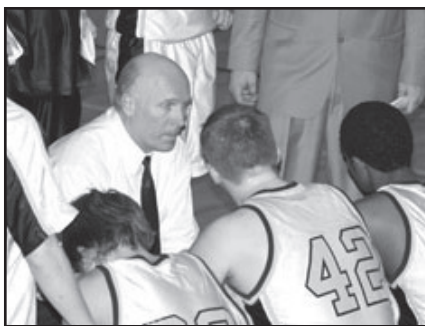

Clinic Overview

This clinic is designed to maximize practice time. Based on two 90 minute practices a week, the clinic is focused on using this valuable time in an effective and practical manner.

Demonstrations and popular drills of today's coaches will be used to show age appropriate techniques for grade school athletes - 5th through 8th grade boys and girls.

Clinics can include:

- Fun and productive shooting drills
- Transition in the format of 3 on 2, 2 on 1 and 3 on 2
- Fast break drills with 5 on 5 mentality
- Transitioning into a 5 person offense-set

Note: All clinics are three hours, but they all have a different focus - Pack the Defense, Man Offense, Zone Offense, and Quick Hitting Zone and Man Sets.

There is something for everyone!

Clinic Breakdown

Each clinic starts the same. The first hour and 40 minutes are dedicated to fundamentals. During that time the following will be covered:

20 Minutes: Teaching and coaching the "total package."

20 Minutes: Practice breakdown.

60 Minutes: Shooting drills, transition breakdown, fast break (3-2/2-1) (3-2/3-2).

Man Offense: St. Charles Clinic

The first man offense designed specifically for grade school basketball. A position spacing offense that relies on putting your athletes in their strength positions. Each position will have a quick-hitting set designed for his/her strength or weakness. (See Zone Offense position summary.)

Pack the Defense: St. Jude Clinic

A team defense concept "ideal" for grade school basketball that always has your athletes in a help position. It is easy to teach and extremely effective.

Zone Offense: Pius XI Clinic

The first Zone Offense designed specifically for grade school basketball. A "free flowing" zone offense that puts your athletes in the best position to make them successful. We will try to mirror most positions strengths and weakness.

Example:

- 5 - A post who can score
- 4 - "More" of a rebounder/picker
- 3 - A middle size athlete, more of a "slasher"
- 2 - Can shoot the shot
- 1 - Normally the best player

Quick Hitting Man-Zone Play: St. Matthias Clinic

This clinic is designed to introduce coaches to a set of quick-hitting zone and man plays. We will also go through a series of zone and man inbound plays.
